Capsicum oleoresin	0.25ml

Cassia oil	0.16 ml
Clove oil	0.08 ml
Turpentine oil	50 ml

INDICATIONS AND USES

Carminative, oral antiferment for ruminants and equines.
Specific treatment for flatulence and colic in ruminants and equines.

CLINICAL PHARMACOLOGY

• DRUG KINETIC:

After oral administration, it is mixed with the ruminal contents of animals and continues advancing towards other compartments of the digestive system until the end of the intestinal portion where it mixes with the stool by which it is eliminated, it has little or no diffusion into other liquids and animal body systems.

• PHARMACODYNAMICS:

TIMPAKAPS oils have antimicrobial activity, which leads to a reduced production of VFA, lactic acid and ammonia nitrogen. It prevents a decrease in the rumen pH and blood pH, at the same time it has activity as anti-inflammatory, digestive stimulant, antiseptic and appetite stimulant.

DOSAGE

Adult bovines and equines: 30 ml.
Calves, foals, caprines and ovines: 15 ml.
Total Dose. The dose should be diluted in ½ liter of water and may be repeated after 30 minutes of starting treatment if the case requires it

WARNING

In equines it should be administered through a nasogastric tube.
Store in a fresh, dry place and away from light sources.
Keep out of the reach of children.
